## 22. Agenda Item No. 12: Any other item with the permission of Chairman:

- (i) Member (SS) raised the issue of less facilities being given to the minority communities other than Muslims due to the reason that their population is lesser than the Muslims. However, these communities should be treated as Micro Minority Communities and more facilities should be given for their upliftment. It was decided to write a letter to Ministry of Minority Affairs in this regard. It was also decided to write to Government of Jharkhand for provision of medical facilities in the pilgrim site of Parasnath in Jharkhand.
- (ii) Member (KKD) raised the following issues:
  - (a) Provision of Endowment Seat for Parsis in Colleges funded by Parsis in Maharashtra.
  - (b) Visa problem for Parsis residing in Pakistan.

    It was decided to write letters to Government of Maharashtra and Ministry of External Affairs, respectively.
- (iii) VC informed the Commission that Government of Kerala is contemplating to send the proposed Church Act to Central Government for their views. As this Act is not supported by any Christians, NCM did not endorse it and Central Government may take its view keeping in mind the sentiments of the Christians.

- (iv) Member (SK) informed the Commission that people from minority communities in Maharashtra are not getting scholarships of the Central Government. She has requested the office to write to Principal Secretary (Education), Government of Maharashtra to get the data of scholarships applied vis-a-vis given to the minority students during the last two years.
- (v) Chairman informed the Commission that a separate meeting will take place to decide pending hearing cases in consultation with Vice Chairman and dispose off the matters on merit.
- (vi) Regarding the number of photographs to be included in the Annual Report 2018-19, it was decided that a maximum of six pages will be allotted to each Member for photographs of their tours and the Members may send the selected photographs to be published in the Annual Report.
