- Presentation on improving the Social Media Status of NCM A presentation on improving the social media status was given by the Media Consultant. She has proposed the following:
 - Utilizing all the features of the apps apart from just posts like story, status, shorts, reels, highlights.
 - b. More use of videos than pictures and pictures than just text.
 - c. Focus on tagging, cross tagging, hashtagging & content circulation
 - d. Members may mention about NCM'S social media presence to the gatherings during their visits with an appeal to follow the accounts.
 - e. Presence on Koo is important like other Ministries and Government bodies. (New platform, easy to gain followers)
 - f. Live broadcast of events/press conferences on Instagram is important (Not full programme but major parts like Chairman's address). This would require a video camera and tripod system.
 - g. Posting of testimonials of beneficiaries due to NCM intervention
 - h. Number of posting in social media to be increased by all.
 - Follower-ship analysis may be done every three months.

The Commission approved all the above proposals. The Media Consultant will impart training to all the personal staff of Chairman, Vice Chairman and Members to make them aware on various aspects of posting at Social Media. The office may take necessary action for the purchase of necessary equipments for making videos. Chairman also directed that all the Social Media links may be printed on the visiting cards of Chairman, Vice Chairman and all the Members.

- 2) The Annual Conference of NCM will be held on 28.03.2023. Shri John Barla, Union Minister of State for Minority Affairs, may be invited for the Conference as a Chief Guest. Shri Prabhu Chawla, Journalist, may also be invited as Chief Speaker for the occasion.
