- 5. In the last meeting of NCM, the channel of submission of grievances and their disposal was revised and it was decided that the files of grievances will be finally disposed off at the level of Joint Secretary and a weekly report will be sent to all Members and Hon'ble Chairman. Keeping in view the request of M (SS) that the files of grievances should continue to be sent to Members, it was decided to reconsider the earlier decision. It was decided that hence forth the processing of petitions may be done at the level of Joint Secretary, however, the final disposal of the grievances of CMS Portal will be done by concerned Members/VC/Chairman.
- 6. It was decided that a meeting with Parsi community may be held at Mumbai.
