


About National Commission for Minorities











National Commission for Minorities

Ministry of Home Affairs Resolution dated 12.01.1978 envisaged the Minority Commission for the enforcement and implementation of safeguards provided for the Minorities in the Constitution, and the law, government policies and administrative schemes.

With the enactment of the **National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992**, the Minorities Commission became a statutory body and renamed as National Commission for Minorities.

- The NCM comprises Chairman, a Vice Chairman and five members.
- It has a term of three years.




Impact through Grievance Resolution


